Welcome to Nashoba North's riding program. Enclosed is a list of riding apparel stores that offer mail order services. We believe that campers must have the proper riding apparel to learn how to ride safely and correctly. All children who are participating in the riding program this summer should bring the following items:

- * Harness helmet with ASTM, SEI certified approval rating,
- * Riding boots, either tall or jodhpur boots,
- * 2 pairs of schooling breeches or jodhpur pants (washable without suede)
(we do not suggest low-rise breeches for active riding)
- * Optional items: 1 riding shirt, Half chaps

Enclosed you will find Nashoba North's riding release form. Please read this form carefully and take a moment to comment on your child's ability and experience. Each rider is screened prior to class assignments.
