



Greetings from Nashoba North,

I hope all finds you healthy and you have been able to successfully adjust to new routines. I am so grateful for all the frontline workers and thoughtful people who have reached out to those in need in their communities. During these past few months we have been busy working on contingency plans to open camp this summer. We have weathered difficult times in past, however it is challenging to prepare for the unknown during this health crisis. Our main priority is to try and ensure the safety and wellbeing of our campers and staff. Yesterday as many of you may have heard our Governor of Maine, Janet Mills, released her plan to open Maine in a phased and methodical order. I believe her primary focus is the welfare and health of our Maine residents. This brought forth many questions on what summer will look like for Nashoba North. We now know we will not be opening on June 24th as scheduled, overnight camps in Maine may open after July 1st .

Our Maine Youth Camping Association has a committee that will be meeting with the Governor's Task Force in the next day or two and I expect to have a much better understanding of how camps might operate this summer. I wish to thank many of the enrolled camper parents who took the time to complete our survey on how they feel about camp this summer. I want you to know we have heard you and we are

At Nashoba North we still await guidance and recommendations from the American Camp Association, our state government, the CDC as well as many of our reliable colleagues in medicine and youth development. We are developing possible scenarios that may include a later start date in July, a merge to one four week session only, family camp or the unfortunate possibility of suspension until 2021. In March we saw the impact the health crisis was having and chose to suspend registration of campers. This has allowed us the time necessary to make program size accommodations if necessary.

I am truly grateful for all the supportive calls and emails, and look forward to welcoming you to Nashoba North this summer if it is appropriate to do so. Wishing you all good health. I hope to be back in touch after May 10th .
