Discovery Program Open to first-time campers completing grades 2-5. A fantastic one-time opportunity to experience Camp Nashoba North for the first time! Enrollment comes with the option of extending your stay with additional fee. Spaces are very limited.

Summit Teen Community Program Camp Nashoba North is proud to offer the Summit Program to 16 & 17 year olds that have completed grade 10 or 11. Summit Program is committed to camp based leadership opportunities and enhanced activity skill development. Summits join local community service projects that are designed to encourage and support public service and stewardship in young people.

FRIENDSHIP CLUB DISCOUNT For families referred directly by a Nashoba Family: A \$500 "new family" discount credit for half a season enrollment, and a referring family receives a matching \$500 credit. A \$1000 "new family" discount credit for a full season enrollment, and a referring family receives a matching \$1000 credit. A \$250 "new family" credit for Discovery enrollment, and a referring family receives a matching credit.

A 10% tuition reduction is available for the second and third siblings in your family providing all attend for 3 or more weeks. Tuition includes laundry service, art supplies, and most trips. All luggage and bags must be shipped to camp *prior to arrival of campers who are flying domestically*. Health insurance is not included. Linen rental is free of charge for international campers.

Electives:

Horseback Riding Lessons

Riding lessons is \$1000 per session or \$550 per Discovery session. Proper attire is required. Private board \$500 per 3.5 week session. **Golf Lessons** Golf lessons (including course greens fee) is \$1000 per session or \$550 per Discovery session. Proper attire is required. **Tutoring** Lessons are available for math, reading and ESL. \$1000 per session or \$550 per Discovery session.

No Worries Deposit & Payment Terms for Early Enrollment Valid through November 1st, 2023:

(a) \$1,500 deposit per child is due with the enrollment application and is credited toward the full tuition when Camp Nashoba North accepts your child's enrollment. **\$1,500.00 is due on December 1, 2022 and February 1, 2023. Remaining Balance is due May 1, 2023.** Enrollments may be canceled with written notice through December 1, 2022 for a full refund less any credit card or bank transfer fee. After December 1, 2022, no payments will be refunded/adjusted unless we are able to immediately fill that spot from a waitlist. Payments are non-transferable. Regardless of payment method, no adjustments, credits, allowances or refunds will be made for late arrival, early withdrawal, early termination of camp operations, or dismissal of Camper. It is strongly recommended that parents purchase camp travel insurance at <https://www.aplusplans.com> to protect their investment in their camper's summer camp experience. Refund checks/credits are issued in September. **(b) Limited right to refund.** If camp operations are

canceled before the date scheduled for the start of the camp season (the "Opening Day"), then parents shall be entitled to a full refund of all payments made or a credit towards next year's camp enrollment for the same camper (a Credit). Camp operations may be canceled in the following circumstances: (i) in the event Camp, in its sole discretion, determines for health or safety reasons that camp operations cannot be safely opened, or if (ii) cancellation is required due to circumstances beyond the control of the Camp, including without limitation, natural disaster, weather, floods, utility failures, inaccessibility, pandemics, communicable disease (including without limitation COVID-19 or other infectious agent –whether or not the possibility shall be foreseeable), civil unrest, government law, order, rule, regulation, mandate, quarantine restrictions, or any similar requirement. Prior to Opening Day, Camp reserves the right to alter the dates of camp season and in the event such alteration reduces the number of days in camp season, Camp may make an equitable adjustment (or credit), as determined by it, for payments made.

(b)**Limited Right to Refund.** If camp operations are canceled before the date scheduled for the start of the camp season, then parents shall be entitled to a full refund of all payments made or a credit towards next year's camp enrollment for the same camper. Camp operations may be canceled in the following circumstances: (i) in the event Camp Nashoba North, in its sole discretion, determined for health or safety reasons that camp operations cannot be safely opened, or if (ii) cancellation is required due to circumstances beyond the control of the camp, including without limitation, natural disaster, weather, floods, utility failures, inaccessibility, pandemics, communicable disease (including without limitation COVID-19 or other infectious agent-whether or not the possibility shall be foreseeable), civil unrest, government law, order, rule, regulation, mandate, quarantine restrictions or any similar requirement. Prior to opening day, Camp reserves the right to alter the dates of the start of camp season and in the event such alteration reduced the number of days in camp season, camp may make an equitable adjustment (or credit), as determined by it, for payments made.

The camp reserves the right to withdraw or expel any camper whose condition, conduct, influencer actions are deemed harmful or disruptive to themselves or others, and will not or cannot abide by the rules and policies of camp. If this occurs no refunds will be made. Parent agrees to make necessary travel arrangements within 24 hours for the return of the child to their possession. During this period the child will not be allowed to participate in camp activities or live with bunkmates. Travel arrangements home and all associated travel expenses will be the responsibility of the parent or guardian. If necessary arrangements are not made, the camp will do so at the expense of the parent or guardian. Use or possession of cell phones, illegal drugs, tobacco, alcohol, fireworks, fighting/harassment, inappropriate language, any other dangerous items/conduct, or tampering with any fire fighting/detection equipment is strictly prohibited and grounds for immediate dismissal without refund. Campers must remain in the cabin after Taps unless by direction of the director.

It is agreed that any dispute or cause of action arising between the parties, whether out of this agreement or otherwise, can only be brought in the District or Superior Court for Cumberland County located in Maine and shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Maine, which parties expressly agree shall be the venue for any such litigation. We are committed to keeping camp enjoyable for everyone. The camp's duties and obligations under this contract shall be suspended immediately without notice during all periods that camp is closed because of force majeure event including but not limited, any fire, act of God, hurricane, war, government action, act of terrorism, be postponed until such time as the camp in its sole discretion, may safely reopen. In the event the camp cannot reopen for to an event under this clause, the camp is under no obligation to refund any portion of tuition paid.

A current physical examination form and medical health history are required of all participants and must be uploaded to CampDoc **no later than June 1, 2023**. The parent/guardian and the physician must sign medical forms in order to attend camp. Proof of valid U.S. medical insurance is required.

Daily uniforms are not required. However, we do require that each camper have at least two Camp Nashoba North t-shirts and one camp sweatshirt. Please refer to our Parent Handbook for proper clothing attire and appropriate Nashoba dress code guidelines. Cell phones, tablet/iPad, video cameras, DVD players, video iPods, any internet access capable device and other consumer electronics are not permitted. Digital cameras are permitted, however movies may never be taken. E-readers should remain at home. Nashoba is a tobacco, alcohol and drug free environment.

Marketing and Media Disclaimer: During the summer and throughout the rest of the year, Camp Nashoba North staff take photographs for several purposes such as yearbooks, brochures, videotapes, slideshows and our website. I grant permission for my child's image or likenesses to be used for camp use and/or promotional or media purposes both now and in the future. Our private photo-sharing account (Bunk1) will give you access to camper photos throughout the summer. The Sebago Lake Region offers many fine restaurants and hotel accommodations for families. Neither campers nor Junior Counselors, under any circumstances, will be allowed to leave camp with relatives without the direct consent of a parent/guardian and the Nashoba Directors.

-All domestic transportation is escorted from the Portland International Jetport and all international flights are met at Boston's Logan Airport. Detailed information will be mailed to you upon enrollment. No bags or luggage will be transported to camp from the Portland Jetport for domestic flights. By enrolling you agree to all guidelines in our Parent Handbook.
